Thank you for communicating to us your interest and concern about the distillate fuel situation.

As you probably know, the regulations for a mandatory allocation of middle distillate fuels became effective November 1, 1973.

Although supplies may not meet one hundred percent of demand, it is hoped that this program will contribute to a more equitable distribution of available supplies.

Administration of this program is the sole responsibility of the Office of Oil and Gas. The Energy Policy Office will be playing no administrative role.
