Dear Mr. President:

I am writing you to urge that you sign S. 1765 which has passed both Houses of the Congress unanimously and which is now before you for signature. This bill was co-sponsored by Senators Riegel and Griffin and by Congressmen Traxler and Brown.

The proposed bill, which is carefully limited to the particular facts of this case, would merely permit the surviving insurer to continue to use the word "Federal" in its new name. The proposed legislation in no way authorizes the use of the word "Federal" in more than one corporate name, and there can be no proliferation of the word "Federal."
