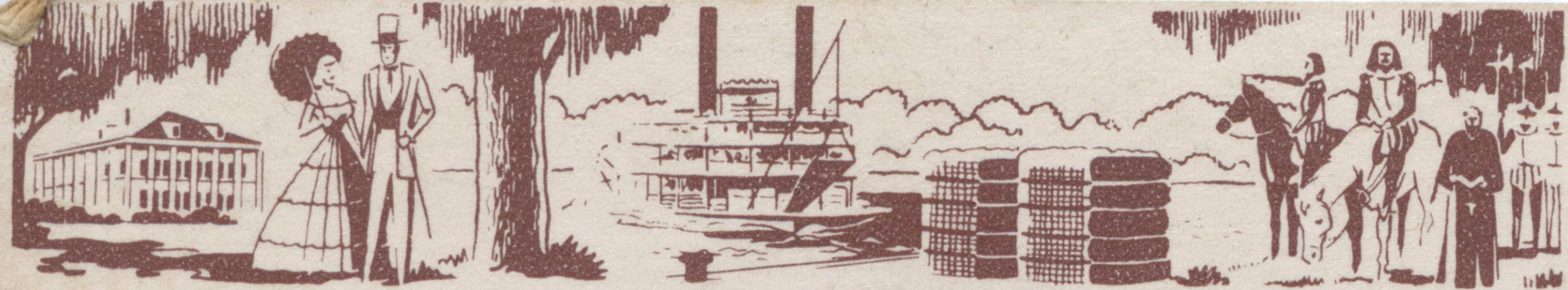

AUBURN—NATCHEZ, MISSISSIPPI . . . Built in 1812, Auburn was one of the most elaborate homes of its time. Its unsupported geometric spiral staircase is a masterwork. In 1911 Auburn and the adjoining property were left to the City of Natchez by the heirs of Stephen Duncan and is maintained as a park and memorial to Mr. Duncan. Open to the public.
