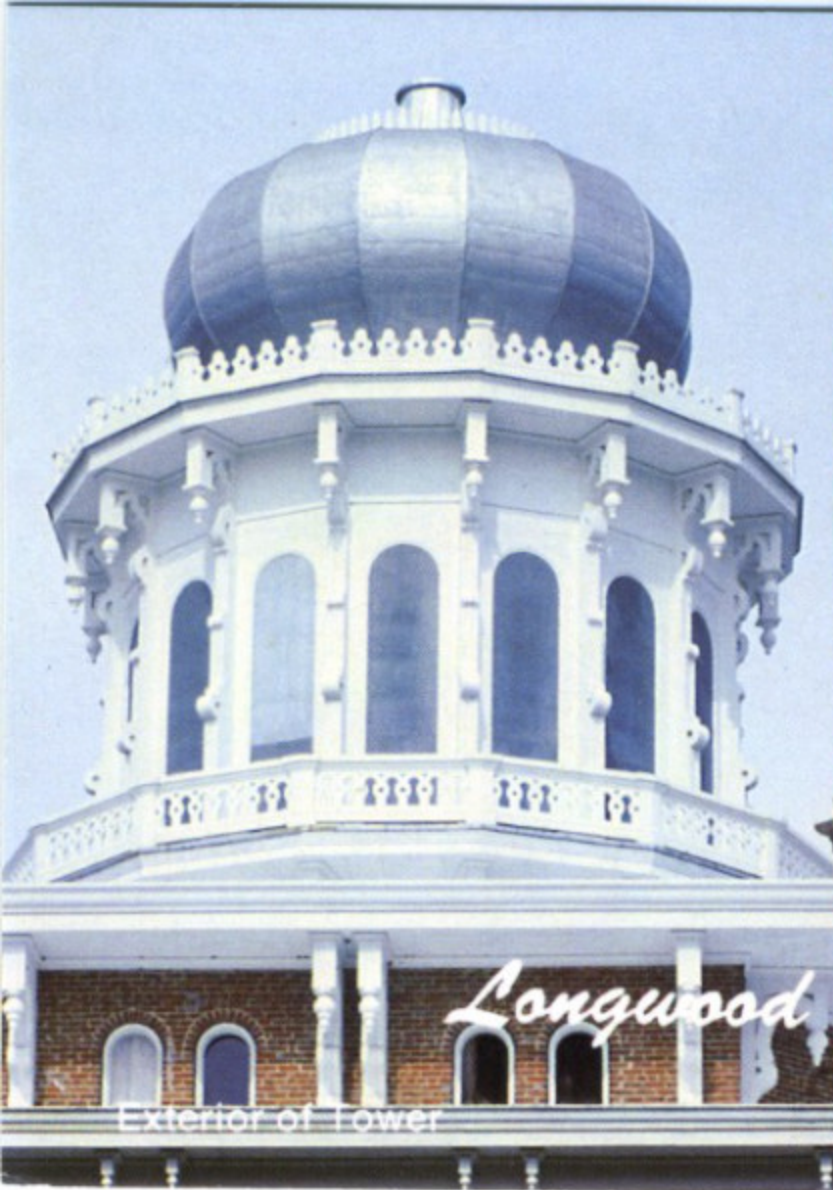

**LONGWOOD PLANTATION**  
**Natchez, Mississippi**

The construction on this plantation house was brought to an abrupt halt when the Civil War began. The carpenters dropped their tools and left, and the work was never completed, with the exception of the first floor. This view is looking up into the octagonal tower, and the construction of the cypress timbers resting on the brick foundation can be seen. The house is now owned by the Pilgrimage Garden Club.
