inspired the birth of the city.



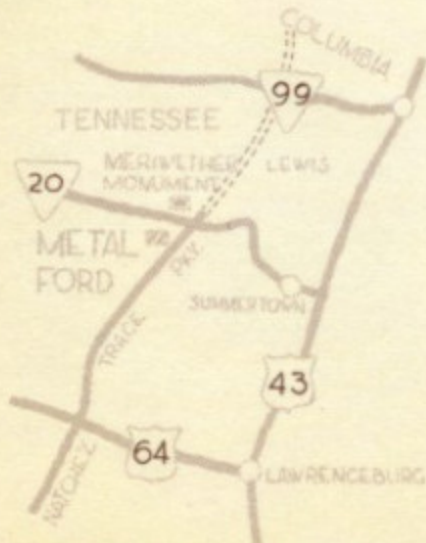


### NATCHEZ TRACE PARKWAY, METAL FORD
