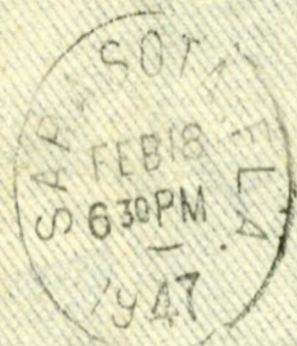

Saw Mrs. Boyle, the pretty lady, on street yesterday said Mr. Boyle came with her and they are visiting his sister. Well my time is going by fast, may leave here Thursday afternoon or not later than Friday morning but don't look for me before Sunday afternoon or night as I'm going to take it slow coming home.

Had your letter this a.m. & one from Boyle this evening when I came in from beach. Saw fire work display last night & it was pretty. The Pageant is in full swing but I don't care any thing <sup>love</sup>

about it and hate the huge crowd.  
Must stop & get to laundry, will run  
by and see Cousin Willie for few minutes,  
then to supper, a long walk and
