This Indenture Made and entered into this
Fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one
thousand Eight hundred and thirty eight
between William G. Irvine of the County of
Marshall and State of Mississippi of the
First Part and Limman D. Treaswell of the County
and State of aforesaid of the Second Part

Witnesseth That for and
in consideration of the sum of one hundred
and fifty Dollars in hand paid the receipt
whereof is here by acknowledged the said Party
of the first Part hath bargained sold and
conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell
and convey unto the Party of the second Part
a certain lot of Land in the Town of
Camaro formerly Jacinto in the County of
Marshall and State of Mississippi represented
in the plan of said Town and known
by No. - 39 - to have and to hold said
lot of Land to the proper use and behoof
of the said Party of the second Part his
heirs and assigns forever free from the
lawful claim or claims of all and
every Person or Persons whatsoever in
testimony whereof the said Party of the first
Part have hereunto set his hand and
Seal the day and year above written
