This Indenture made this day of
1847 between John Carruth of the first
part & Mr Oats & James Oats of the other
part (all of Marshall County State of Miss)
as commissioners and their successors in
office to take charge of a Burgyny granted
for the public benefit of the Citizens of Lawan
and the surrounding country. Whereby
that for and in consideration of the
sum of one Dollar in hand paid to the
said John Carruth at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents & further for
and in consequence of the neighborhood affluence
& regard he the said John Carruth has for
his neighbors he has given granted barg^d
& sold & does hereby give and grant unto
the said party of the second part as com-
missioners & their successors in office as the rep^s
sentatives of this place for the improv^d purpos^s
of a public burgyny ground aff^d with an under-
standing hereby made that the majority of the
inhabitants members of the several worshipping
congregations shall and may at any time appoint
other commissioners, on the death resignation
removal or refusal to serve of any of the
the land herein after conveyed
aff^d the same as the party
part above named viz all
