Sir I have some business in your neighbourhood to transact and as I have no acquaintances there Mr Well has advised me to confide it <sup>with</sup> you I send you two small notes one on Mr Herbert and the other on Mr Giles Crain whom I have been informed is about Lamar he is from Texas if Mr Crain is in the neighbourhood yet please to endeavour to have the money collected of him without delay deal with Mr Herbert as you think best and oblige yours &c
