This Indenture made and entered into
this Twenty fifth day of June in
the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and Forty Two between James
Allen Trustee for the Commissioners
or proprietors of the Town of Camar
formally Incorporated in the County of
Marshall and State of Mississippi of
the first part and Jeremiah Treadwell
of the County and State aforesaid
of the Second part Witnesseth
That for and in Consideration of the
sum of Two Hundred Dollars in
hand paid by the party of the second
part the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged the said Party of the
first part have bargained sold and
conveyed and by these presents do bargain
sell and convey unto the said Party of
the second part Ten Town Lots in the
Town of Camar formally Incorporated known
and referred to the plan of said Town
by Number Fifty three (53) Fifty four (54)
Fifty five (55) Fifty six (56) ~~Fifty seven (57)~~
Fifty seven (57) Eighty (80) Sixty nine (69)
Eighty one (81) Eighty two (82) Eighty three (83)
and Eighty seven (87) all in the County
of Marshall and State of Mississippi to have
and to hold said Lots in said Town to
the proper use and behoof of the said
party of the second part his heirs and
assigns for ever free from the lawful
Claim or claims of all and every person
or persons what soever
