## Promissory Note, 30 April 1849

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**The State of Mississippi Marshall County.**

I JOHN R. McCARROLL, Sheriff and Tax Collector of the county of Marshall, have this day according to law, sold the following tract of Land to wit:

*The West half of the North West Quarter of Section No Twenty four in Township No Two of Range No Two west of the Base Meridian Arkansas Territory*

as the property of *Mosey C. Dawson* for the taxes due on the *Map of the State of 1844 of 125 32 R2 West* for the year 1848, with legal costs and charges thereon to wit: The sum of

*Two 39/100 Dollars* when *James C Alderson* became the best bidder, at the sum of *Two 39/100 Dollars*

I therefore sell and convey said *Map of the State of 1844 of 125 32 R2 West* to *James C Alderson* heirs, &c., forever. Given under my hand and seal, this *Third* day of
