that I H. Valentine do hereby  
bind myself to W. L. Freedwell  
in the penal sum of Ten  
Thousand dollars. The Condition  
of which bond is, that the same  
shall be void and of no effect  
if I the said Valentine do  
faithfully settle up the unsettled  
Law business of the firm of  
Freedwell & Valentine. And  
I also bind myself to save  
harmless the said Freedwell on  
all prosecution bonds hereafter  
signed by him for the prosecution  
of suits in which Freedwell  
& Valentine are attys for the
