or Lot and bargained premises with all
and singular the appurtenances thereto
belonging or in any wise appertaining
For and in Consideration of the sum of Twenty
five Dollars in hand paid the Receipt where
of is here by acknowledged I further Relinquish
all my rights title and interest in and to said
Lot Section in Law or Equity unto the afore
said L. L. Feadwell his heirs and assigns
for ever, from my heirs and assigns.
