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
This Indenture made and entered into this the

Witnesseth that for and
in Consideration of the sum of Fifteen Dollars in
hand paid by the Party of the second part, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Party of
the first part hath this day bargained, sold
and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain
sell convey and confirm unto the Party of the
second part his heirs and assigns a certain lot of
land lying and being in the plot of the Town
of Samar, formerly Jacinto, in the County of
Marshall and State of Mississippi. The same
being known as lot number two (2) and a portion
of lot number one (1) beginning at the North East
Corner of, formerly, Thomas Barnetts lot no. one (1)
thence running East to lot number three (3), thence
South to the alley - thence West to the South
West Corner of lot no. one (1). (a portion of said
lot no. one (1) being owned by A. J. Humphrey?) thence
running North twenty nine feet, thence East
seven feet, thence North forty five feet, thence
East two feet, thence North twenty five
feet to the beginning.

or in anywise appertaining to the Party of the


Second part his heirs and assigns for ever, and
