This Indenture made and entered
into this Twenty eighth day of Septemb-
er in the year of our Lord one tho-
usand eight hundred and fifty six
Between G. Smith and Elizabeth Smith
his wife of the one part of the county
of Marshall and State of Mississippi, and
J. S. Treadwell of the same county and
State aforesaid of the other part, Witness
-eth that for and in consideration of the
sum of fifty dollars to us in hand paid
by the said J. S. Treadwell the receipt-
whereof is hereby acknowledged we
have and do hereby by these presents bargain
sell alien and convey to the said J.
S. Treadwell his heirs and assigns a certai-
n Town Lot in the county and State
aforesaid known and designated on the pla-
n of the Town of Lamar Depot as Lot
no (3) Thence to have and to hold the afores-
aid Town lot and bargained premises with
the appurtenances thereunto belonging and we
the said G. Smith and Elizabeth his wife
do hereby covenant and agree to, and with
the said Treadwell his heirs and assigns
that we will warrant and for ever defend
the title to the above designated Town Lot aga-
-inst the legal claim of any and all persons who
-to come given under our hands & seals day &
date above written
