Missippi 3 presents that I Kucher  
Marshall County have this day agreed with  
J L Treadwell as follows (viz) I agree to  
pay J L Treadwell out of the proceeds of the  
first Cotton ginned One Hundred and fifty  
Bales for one Service Mule which J L Treadwell  
is to assist in all the grinding Ginning and  
hauling on J L Treadwell plantation until  
paid for or until the first of January next  
J L Treadwell is not to be disposed of until  
paid for On forfeiture of the price of the  
same belongs our hands and seals this  
15th day of December 1866.
