Aaron Bridges for and in consideration of the Sum of one hundred pounds
Current Money of said State & him in hand paid by the said William Bridges
The Receipt & Payment the said Aaron Bridges doth hereby Acknowledge
He the said Aaron Bridges hath Bargained And Sold And Doth by these Presents
Bargain And Sell Alien And Confirm unto the said William Bridges his heirs
And assigns For ever. A certain Tract of one hundred Acres of Land situate
Lying & being in the County & State Above Mentioned on the Est Side of main road
Broad River And Bounded as Follows Beginning at a White oak on the
N^o Bank of the River thence N^o 154 poles crossing a Branch three times to
A Chesnut, thence N^o 156 poles to a White oak on the N^o bank of the River
thence Down the River 50 poles to a Stake ~~at~~ his own corner thence S^o along his own
Line 150 poles to the River thence Down the River ~~to~~ to the beginning

With all and singular the Divisions and Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents and
Services of the said Premises And of every Part thereof. And all the Estate Right Title
Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of him the said Aaron Bridges in and
To the said tract of Land & Premises. With all and singular the said Premises above mentioned
And every Part and parcel thereof. With the appurtenances unto the said William Bridges his
Heirs and assigns for ever. And the said Aaron Bridges and his heirs the said Land and
Premises. and every Part thereof Against him and his heirs and against all Persons
Whatsoever. Well warrant And For ever Defend. the said Land & Premises unto the said
William Bridges his heirs & assigns for ever. in Witness Whereof the said Aaron Bridges hath
hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the Day & Year First above Written
