Know all men by these presents that I
J. Treadwell ~~am~~ ~~of~~ an heir and formally
bound unto Smith Wilkins in the sum of one
hundred dollars to be recovered from me my
heirs Exors Adors and assigns 16 days the 31st
Aug 1833

The condition of the above obligation
is such that if the above bound Treadwell
Treadwell shall stand to and abide by the
decision of David Hamrick & Wm G. Brown
and if they can not agree for them to
choose and employ an arbitrator to settle a matter
of controversy pending between the heirs of
Charles Wilkins and the heirs of Ruth Treadwell
died on a deficiency of land on the part of
Wilkins and the balance due on a note
on the part of Treadwell
