Dear Sir

Your very polite note of this morning is to hand and its contents particularly noticed; and in reply thereto, we must inform you that we do not consider that we have the right either legal or moral to sell, either in fee simple or lifetime interest <sup>any</sup> ~~the~~ lands belonging to the Estate of Samuel Raymire dec<sup>d</sup>. Was the Land <sup>all</sup> our own, your request would be promptly met, and we would be much pleased to do public good were there not other interests,

You will be so kind as to say to your neighbours; that it is not for want of esteem towards them, that we do not grant ~~them~~ the privilege of building a school house ~~on~~ on the Land belonging to said Estate, but because we do not believe that <sup>it would be</sup> ~~we have the right to~~ do so,

We are all in good health and would be pleased to see you or any part of your family at any time. Come down and see us as soon as convenient, we will pay you a visit as early as suitable.
