TO: ALL CITIZENS' COUNCIL MEMBERS

The officers of many local Citizens' Council organizations have asked for lists of questions to be answered by candidates for local offices in this year's elections.

As an example, we are enclosing a list of questions which one local Council is sending to candidates for county and city elections.

These questions are mailed by registered mail, with return receipt requested, and return envelope enclosed.

The results are then published as a paid ad in the local newspaper or distributed in pamphlet form.


Whether or not these questions are asked of local candidates is left entirely to the local Citizens' Council organization.

Deadline for candidates to qualify is by five o'clock, P. M., sixty days prior to the date of the First Primary, or June 9, 1967.

The First Primary Election is August 8, 1967.

The Second Primary Election is August 29, 1967.

The General Election is November 7, 1967.
