

These questions are mailed by registered mail, with return receipt requested, and return envelope enclosed.

The results are then published as a paid ad in the local newspaper or distributed in pamphlet form,

Whether or not these questions are asked of local candidates is left entirely to the local Citizens' Council organization.

Deadline for candidates to qualify is by five o'clock, P. M., sixty days prior to the date of the First Primary, or June 9, 1967.

The First Primary Election is August 8, 1967.

The Second Primary Election is August 29, 1967.

The General Election is November/7, 1967
