We have people here of various backgrounds and specialities. In a sense, our backgrounds or specialities break us into several interest groups. Why not have each group study and come up with a project for its area? Examples of what I have in mind are such groups and possible projects as:

Group	Project
Lawyers	Legal aid. Use law students? But try to avoid Ole Miss Law School problem.
Doctors	Medical help for the poor. Palo Alto. Mount Bayou (Tufts).
Education	In the small towns across our state, Blacks are going from shack to Black schools and back to shacks. Need some- thing outside their environments. Organize several touring talks: a) different professions and vocations with literature. (Recruitment?) b) importance of college c) various foreign countries (slide talk) d) how democracy works or should work e) Black success stories (have the Black who made good talk on how he did it)
Housing	Farmers Home Administration. Newspaper advertisement.
Business	Consulting group for minority businesses. Roxbury project in Boston.

A lawyer could be appointed head of his interest group with the responsibility of structuring a project for his area; a doctor for his group, etc. Each group leader could study his area in depth, get information on projects done in other parts of the country, and make a report in a month or two at a meeting similar to this one. Approval for the project could be obtained at that time.
