May 19<sup>th</sup> 1864

Major Genl Johnston

Sir

The 33<sup>rd</sup> Pa<sup>ri</sup>ge Vol<sup>s</sup>  
under my command were mustered  
into the U S Service for the war  
in the Provisional Army under the  
act for local defence and special  
service, and number two hundred  
in our muster roll, comprising  
the funds employed in the Army  
of Cook & Boston for contracts  
for arms, but ordered to report  
to Genl Howell Cobb for duty which  
was done, we are well armed with  
Enfield rifles of Col Bos Manufacture  
and 40 rounds of ammunition all  
turned over to us by the Govt, I feel  
it my duty to notify you of our  
organization should you desire our  
services we can move immediately
