My dear Major,

It occurred to me
in looking at the return of the A.
of T. for May 1st 1864, that in
your statement published by me
and attacked by Hood in his N.O.
article, Coart's brigade (1395 effect-
ive) is included twice. In that re-
port, as it is, although on its way
to the army, and again in the 8000
of Polli's troops you report as join-
ing at Resaca on the 13th - There
again on the other side - On the re-
turn of May 1st is a remark
that 814 (effective) of Mucci's bri-
gade arrived after the return

was made is not included. So it
seems to me not to have ap-
peared in the accession to our
strength. It seems to me, there-
fore, that our statement of ac-
cessions is too large by the differ-
ence ^{between} $1395 + 814 = 581$.

This is of no consequence. I
only thought that you, not hav-
ing the returns, might like to
know the fact.
