Dear Sir

All the Boxes are heard from but Rogers Brownings & South East, and this Box half counted out and you are about 20 votes ahead of Howry. You & Howry are running close at this box - it will be a tie. At Brownings only about 30 votes are polled & Howry will get two thirds of them. At Rogers you will beat him 30 or 40 votes. Wilson was at South East Monday - made a speech - and worked hard but I don't think he effected much. You know we have put your majority in So East at 50. So we think you have beaten Howry in this county and Howry's friends all give it up. Wilson so far as heard from has got about 10 votes although Pelcher & the Cooks went it strong for him. Saw a fellow from Danola who said you got every vote at Danola C.H. Have heard frequently in the last few days that you would get a majority in that County. We will give you full returns next mail. Let us have returns of eastern Counties as you get them - Mail closing
