

## **About the Civic Chorale**

The Illinois State University Civic Chorale is a chorus comprised of ISU students and community members. It was founded in 1968 by the School of Music and celebrates its 50th Anniversary this year. Civic Chorale is directed by Professor John Koch, who has expertise in choral music and opera. In its membership of more than 100 choristers are ISU undergraduate and graduate students, music majors and non-majors, and community members from many walks of life including physicians and nurses, clergy, teachers, businessmen and women, secretaries, clerical staff, homemakers, and retirees.

The ISU Civic Chorale performs concerts every academic semester as a "stand-alone" chorus, but it also has joined other ISU choral groups and the ISU Symphony Orchestra in performances of large choral works, symphonies, and oratorios. In addition to masterworks, the Civic Chorale performs works by contemporary composers such as Eric Whitacre, Dan Forrest, John Rutter, and others. Civic Chorale has been invited to perform an annual holiday concert at the McLean County Museum of History during its "Once upon a December..." celebration in December. The ensemble has also performed in local churches, Chicago, Springfield, and Europe.

Civic Chorale rehearses Monday nights from 7 to 9 p.m. during the academic year. New members who have singing experience are always welcome to join!
