Verbal Description:

The piece appears to be a human right foot with the toe (partially broken off) of the far left considerably larger than the toe on the far right. The foot thickness changes from lam is just above the toes to 1.4cm where the break occurred. Looking at the piece such that the large toe is on the left from the top of the foot, the opposite side of the foot, now called the bottom, is essentially flat with the toes curving upward. The top of the foot rises moving from the toes toward what would be the ankle. The largest toe has broken surfaces on the top and the bottom, both essentially parallel with the foot.
