


The Miami Neuroscience Institute had a successful 8th Annual Miami Neuro Symposium and 7th Annual Neuro Nursing Symposium. Over 200 participants attended from 20 states and 6 countries! The American Heart/American Stroke Association presented Baptist Hospital of Miami, South Miami Hospital, and West Kendall Baptist Hospital with Get With The Guidelines Awards for our data that demonstrate excellence in stroke care.

### **Research Compliance Corner**

The Center for Research is responsible for reviewing and providing compliance confirmation for research studies conducted at Baptist Health South Florida (BHSF). Compliance confirmation provided for individual is compliance and for study specific compliance. Confirmation for an individual is specific to an individual's compliance with BHSF's requirements to participate in research: Clinical Conflicts of Interest (CCOI) Form, CITI COI training, and CITI Human Subject (Social/Biomedical) training. Individual compliance can be provided via email and should not be used in IRBNet for study confirmation. Study-specific compliance confirmation must be done via IRBNet. This confirms that all personnel on the study have completed requirements, have been reviewed for conflicts of interest, and all conflicts (if any are present) have been addressed.

BHSF also requires that all research personnel (physicians, sub-investigators, coordinators, etc.) update their CCOI form upon acquiring any new financial relationships and or increased payments (remuneration, royalties, stock/stock options, travel, etc.) exceeding \$5,000 and therefore becoming a significant financial interest.
