

Citizen science and Linguistics

- · Crowdsourcing:
 - Transcription of texts
 - NLP
 - Corpus compilation
- Successful examples in lexicography:
 - ✓ Oxford English Dictionary (19th century)
 - ✓ Čibej et al., 2015 for Slovene



NeoUSAL neology observatory

- ✓ Castilla y León
- ✓ 10 local newspapers
- ✓ Twice a month
- ✓ Since 2009

Face-to-face survey


- In a public library

- Contact and feedback







- Protocol gamification




