



ADA LOVELACE DAY & WIKIPEDIA EDIT-A-THONS

- Honors Ada Lovelace, an English mathematician and writer commonly known as the first computer programmer
- Founded by Suw Charman-Anderson, former Executive Director of the Open Rights Group, in 2009 & held every year on the second Tuesday of October https://findingada.com/
- Wikipedia edit-a-thons events to encourage more participation in Wikipedia editing by and about underrepresented groups
 - ~ 17% of biographies in Wikipedia are about women
 - ~ 13 15% of Wikipedia editors are women


OBJECTIVES
