Conductor, violinist, composer, and educator **Paul S. Kim** is an assistant professor of music at Old Dominion University, where he directs the ODU Symphony Orchestra, teaches applied violin and conducting, and oversees the string and chamber music programs. He also serves as music director for the Orchestra of the Eastern Shore and the Albemarle Sinfonia, as well as assistant conductor of the Richmond Philharmonic Orchestra. Previously, he served as assistant conductor and principal second violinist of the Piedmont Symphony Orchestra, and he has enjoyed guest-conducting performances with the Roanoke Symphony, Waynesboro Symphony, and others. On the popular side, Dr. Kim was the conductor for Eurythmics star Dave Stewart and his Rock Fabulous Orchestra. As a violinist, he is a current member of the Roanoke Symphony Orchestra and has performed with the Virginia Symphony Orchestra, Fairfax Symphony Orchestra, and many others.

Dennis Zeisler has been on the faculty of Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Virginia for 36 years serving as Director of Bands, Professor of Clarinet and Saxophone and Chair of the Music Department. Mr. Zeisler is a graduate of the University of Michigan where he was solo clarinetist of the Symphony Band under the direction of Dr. William D. Revelli. He was solo clarinetist of the Detroit Concert Band under the direction of Dr. Leonard Smith and clarinet soloist with the United States Military Academy Band at West Point. Mr. Zeisler is a past recipient of the Virginia Music Educator of the Year Award, is a member of the American Bandmasters Association and is the founder and conductor of the Virginia Wind Symphony. He is on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association, The John Philip Sousa Foundation, The Midwest Clinic and holds the office of President of the American Bandmasters Association.
