

An Introduction to Perinatal Hepatitis C

Quick Facts

- HCV is associated with IV drug use
- Increasing with opioid epidemic
- 5-10% vertical transmission
- Early onset liver fibrosis, cirrhosis, HCC




Problem

Guidelines: screen by antibody testing at 18 months


Reality: the diagnosis is inconsistently carried forward after birth. Children with documented exposure to HCV are not being screened.

Baby with HCV exposure **Exposure Documented Track diagnosis Retain in Care** Test HCV at 18 mo + test? Confirmation with PCR, functional monitoring and HCV treatment






Results: Recent FOCUS Data
