# NUI Maynooth Teaching and Learning Showcase

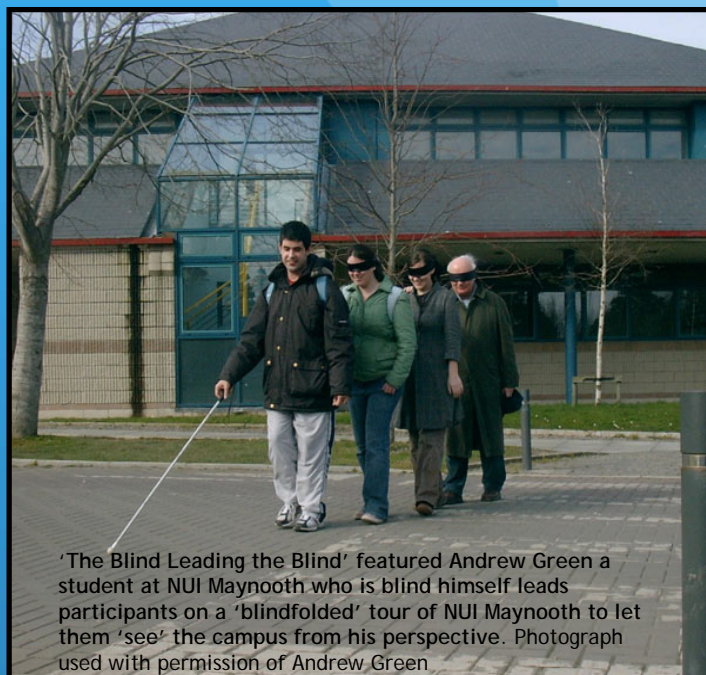

**Title:** Library pilot in conjunction with the NUI Maynooth Staff Development Office of the National Disability Authority (NDA) eLearning “Disability Equality training course”

**Subject:** Staff Development in the Library, NUI Maynooth

### Overview of Best Practice/Innovation:

An online self-directed course on disability equality was piloted with Library staff with a view to the course being rolled out campus wide.

### How it Worked:

- Expressions of interest were sought from library staff
- Eight staff were selected as part of the pilot
- A link to the course was sent to each participant
- Staff studied the course on their own and provided support to each other
- Upon completion feedback was sought from staff via an online survey
