Figure 1 Key plan

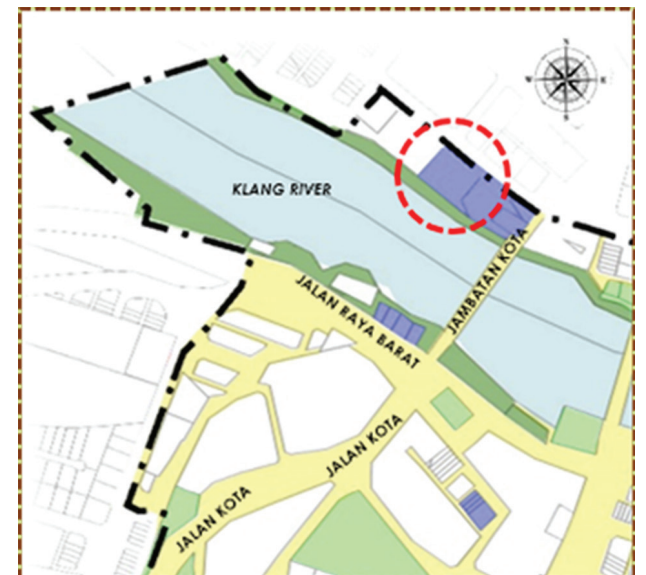


Figure 2 Location Plan

#### 1. PERGOLA

Forming a shaded walkway, and sitting area with a sturdy open lattice.



#### 2. BINS

Are placed alongside paths frequently walked by visitors, encourages people to avoid littering.



#### 3. WATER FEATURE

Versatil feature for a landscape enjoyed by all ages, improve environment of the site.



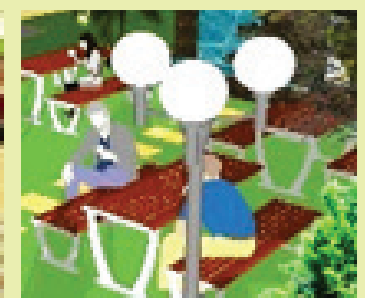
#### 4. WATER FOUNTAIN

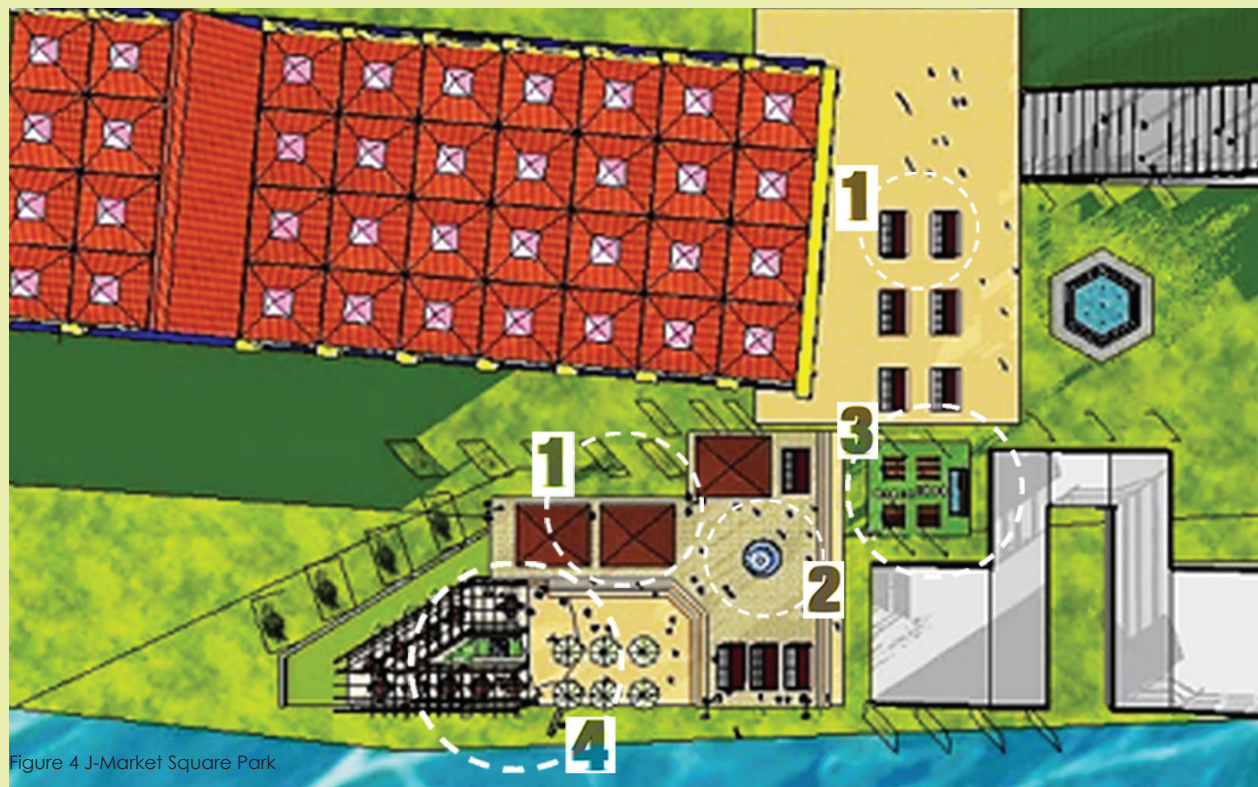


Figure 4 J-Market Square Park
