





CONCLUSION

Cont.....

- To overcome such challenges, the curricula of religious education at both official and private levels must be reviewed and updated to cope up with current trends to help societies understand correctly the teachings of Islam.
- Put aside the doctrinal differences in the jurisprudential issues, trying to converge between different points of view, accepting the other opinion, avoiding controversy and clinging to opinion, spreading the culture of tolerance, and establishing systems of practicing freedoms in light of the teachings of Islam.
