Panel Title: Meet the Editors in Chief

Panel Facilitator: Carol Brown

Panel Topic: This panel will provide an opportunity for the Editors-in-Chief of a wide variety of IS journals to briefly introduce themselves and state their journal's missions, as well as any recent changes in the journal. Following the introductions, each editor will go to a separate table where he/she will have copies of recent journals and pamphlets about the journal and will be available for Q&A with attendees to the session.

Target Audience: we expect the panel to be of interest to a wide cross-section of conference attendees

Panel Objectives: to give young researchers the opportunity to meet the EICs from various journals and to give the EICs of some of the less widely known journals an opportunity to showcase their journal.

Panel Format: The moderator will first introduce herself and her journal, setting by example the intended time and brevity of the introductions. Each EIC will then introduce him/herself. This should take roughly 15 minutes. The remainder of the session will then consist of the Q&A at the break-out tables.
