leather and copper













































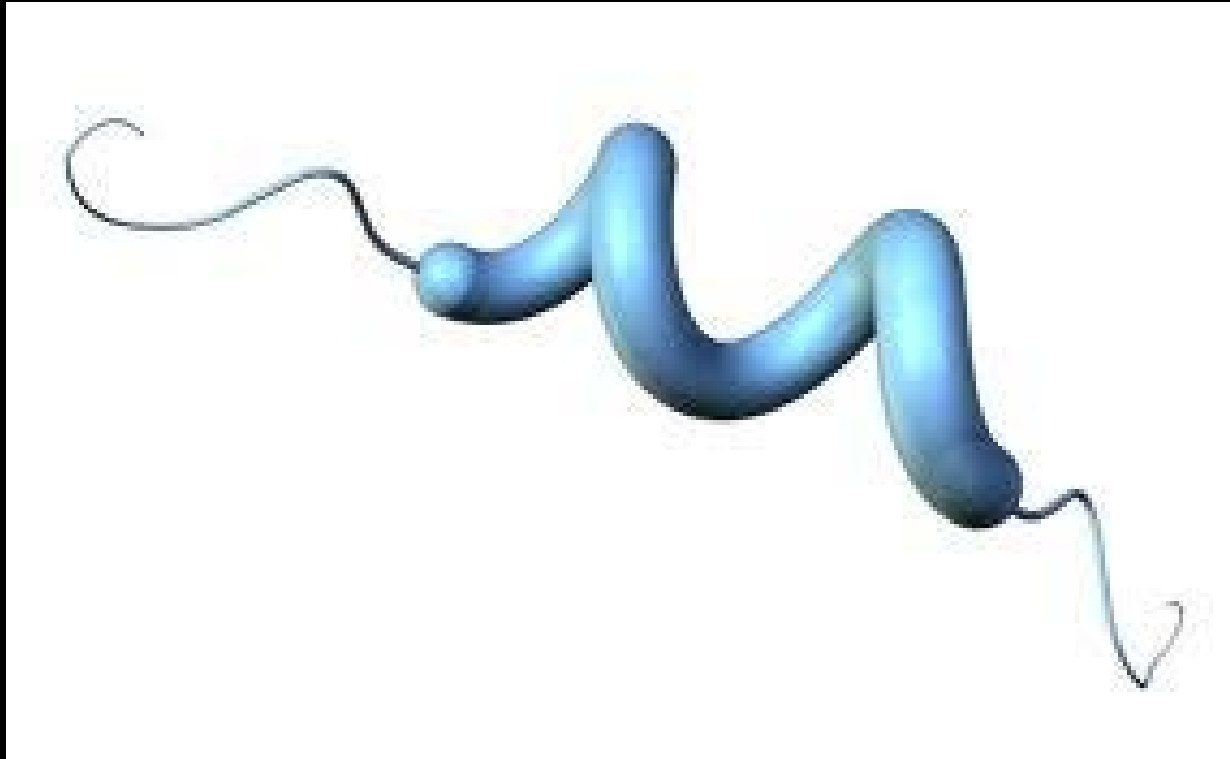
