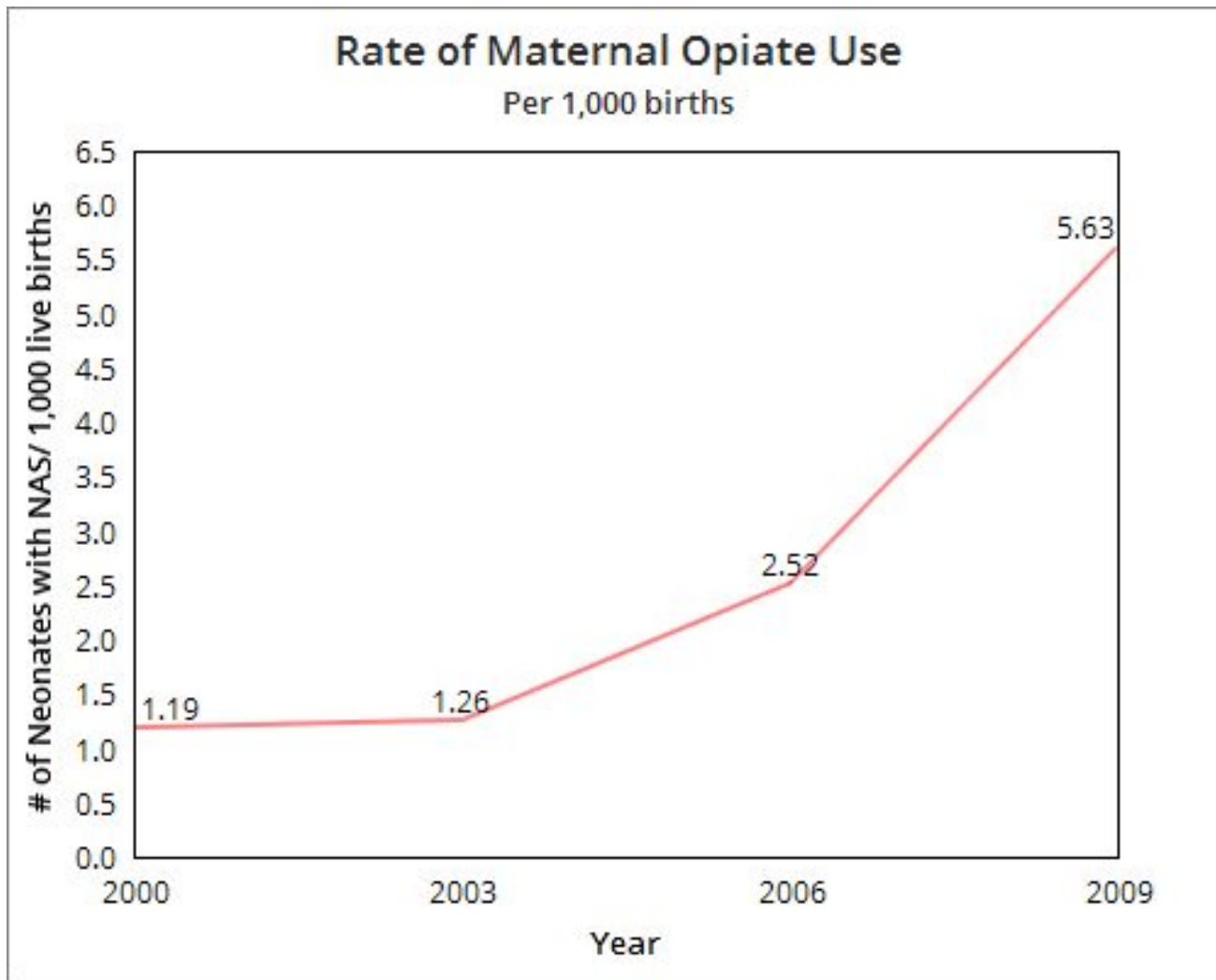

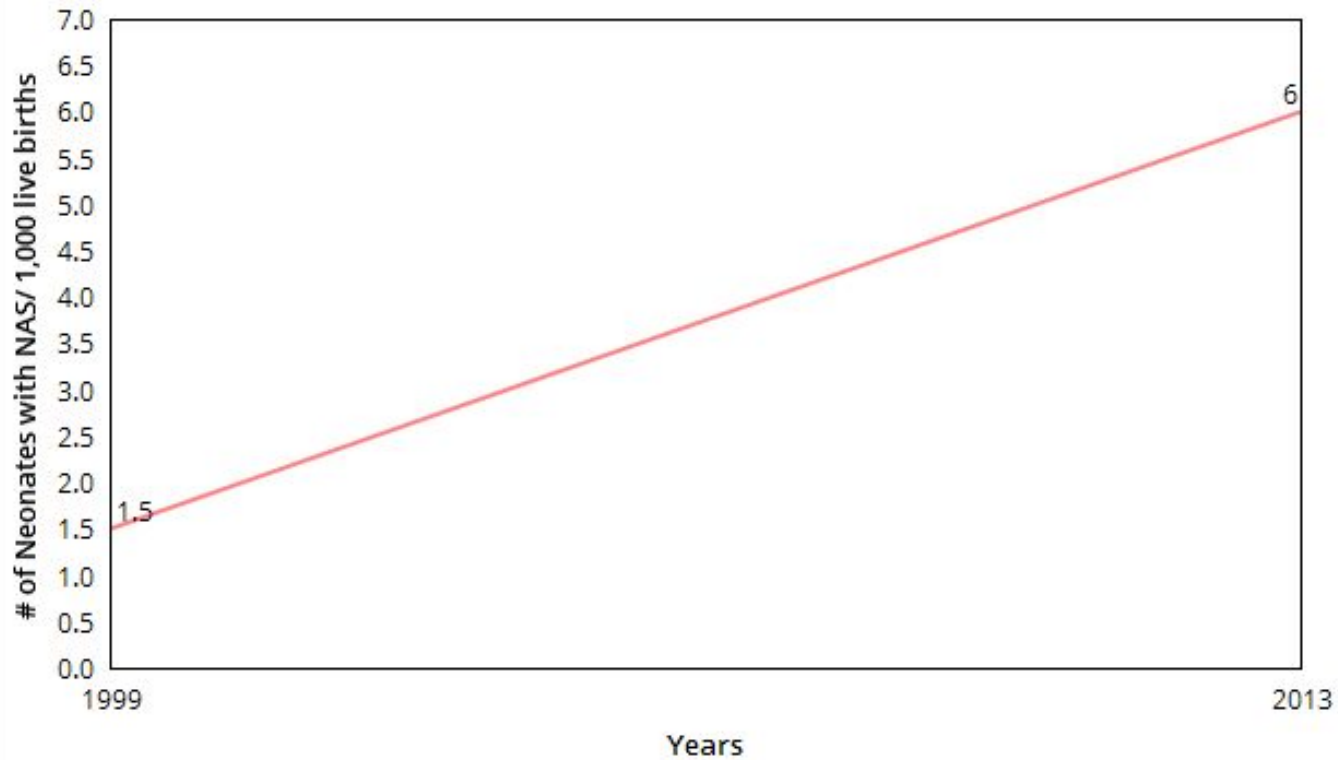

## Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome in the US



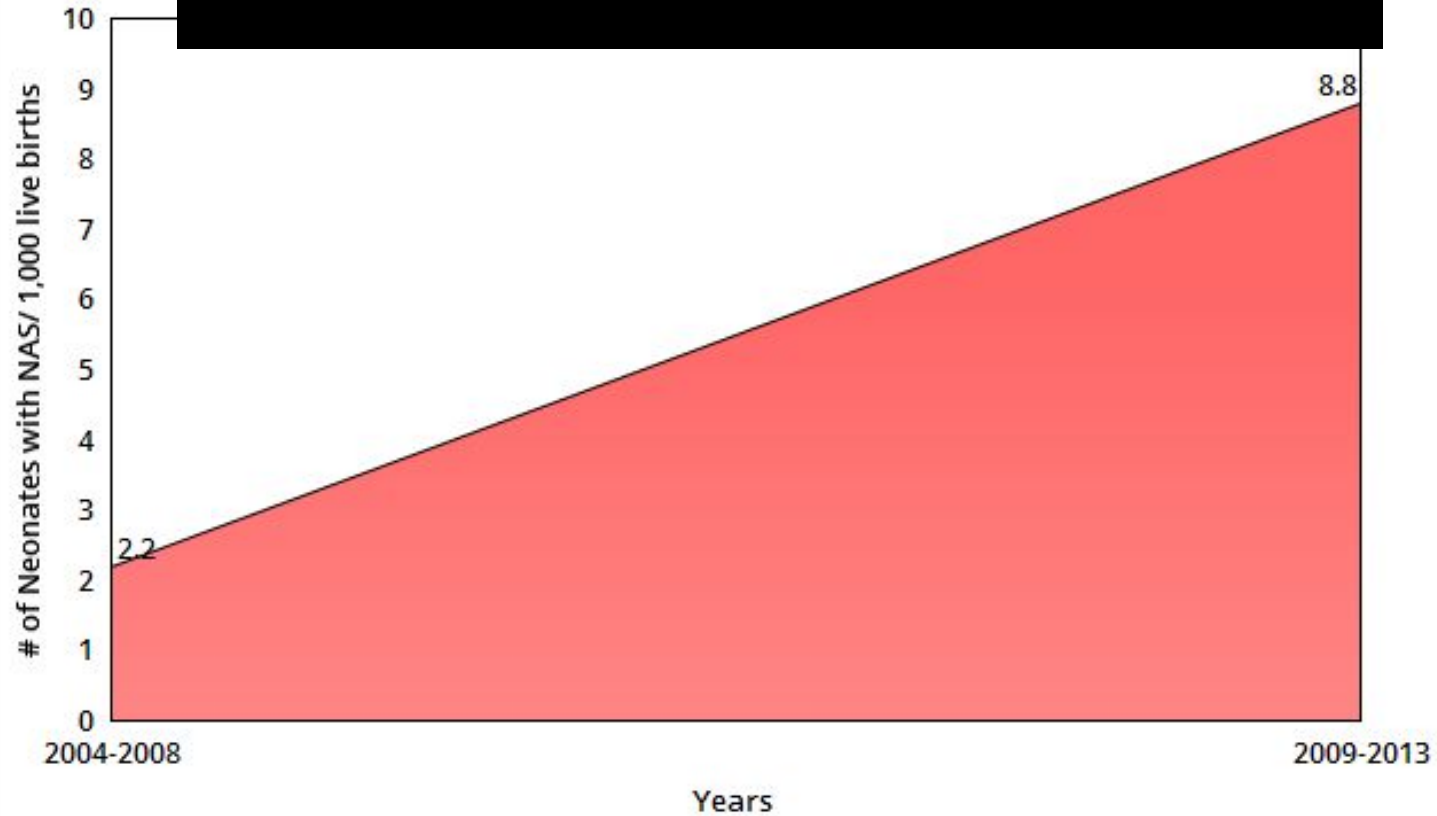

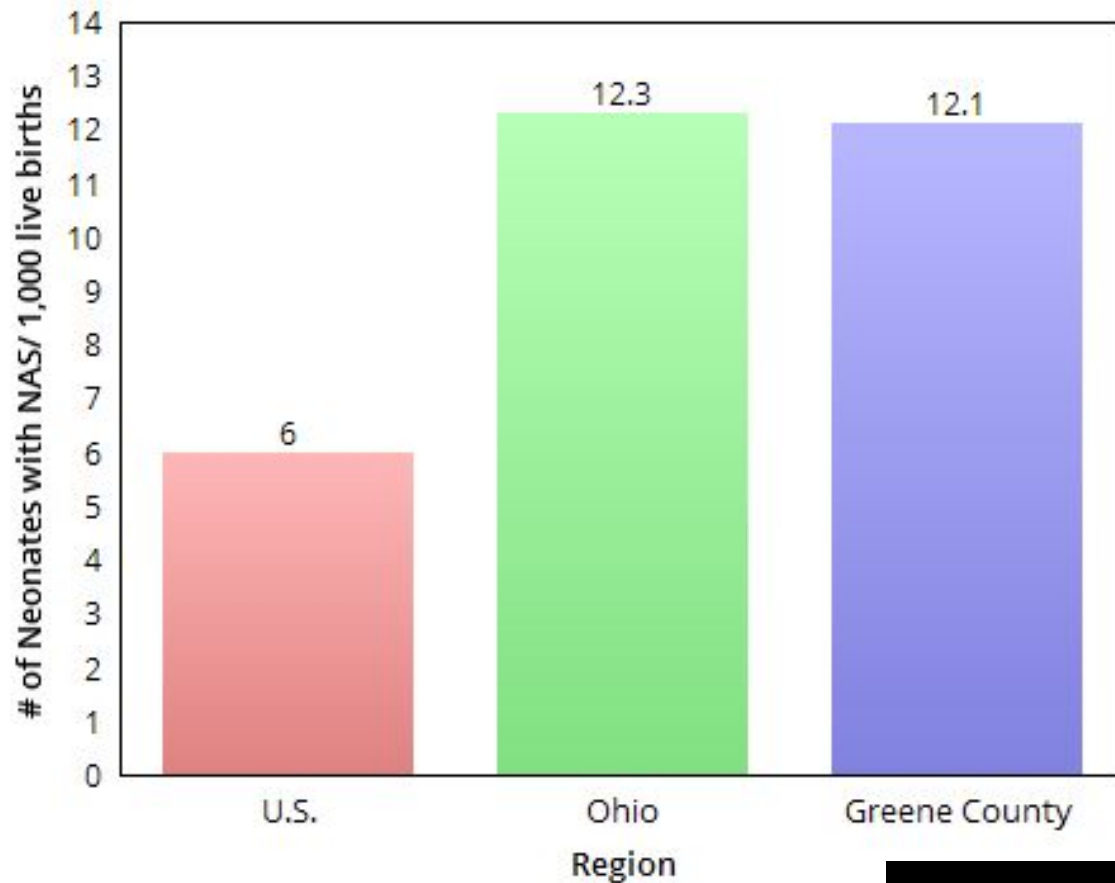


# Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome in Ohio
