Here are the data obtained on the complete blood grouping tests performed on the blood specimen recently submitted. This is the blood specimen from Mrs. Marilyn Sheppard which Miss Cowan handed me personally on July 7 at 8:40 A.M.

Therefore Mrs. Sheppard is a type O Rh negative, type MS, Kell negative and Duffy positive. These reactions were entirely satisfactory although somewhat slow in a few cases. The M and S reactions were excellent although the Duffy(F) was weak. Each of these reactions was confirmed by the inclusion of known positive control bloods. Furthermore, the International type O finding was corroborated by the demonstration of A and B antibodies in the Sheppard serum.
