Physical features

Measurements: h: 0.225 * w: 0.283 * t: 0.17

State of conservation: Small fragment from the upper part of the stele, topped with a cymatio or a pediment, of which a tiny portion of the bottom moulding is preserved; the left side and the back are preserved.
