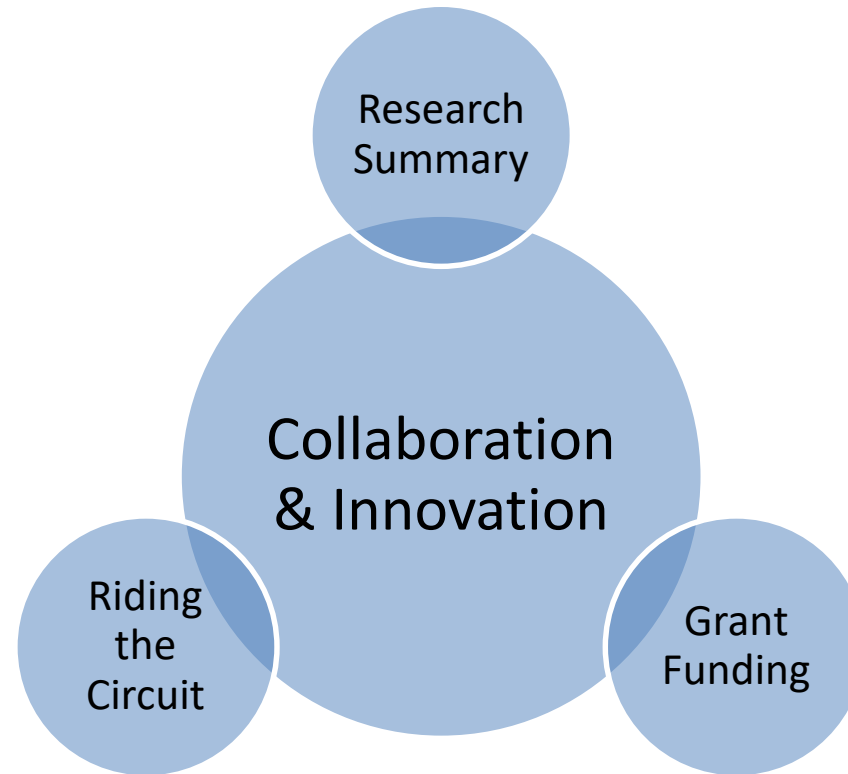

- Avoid the Pursuit of Perfection

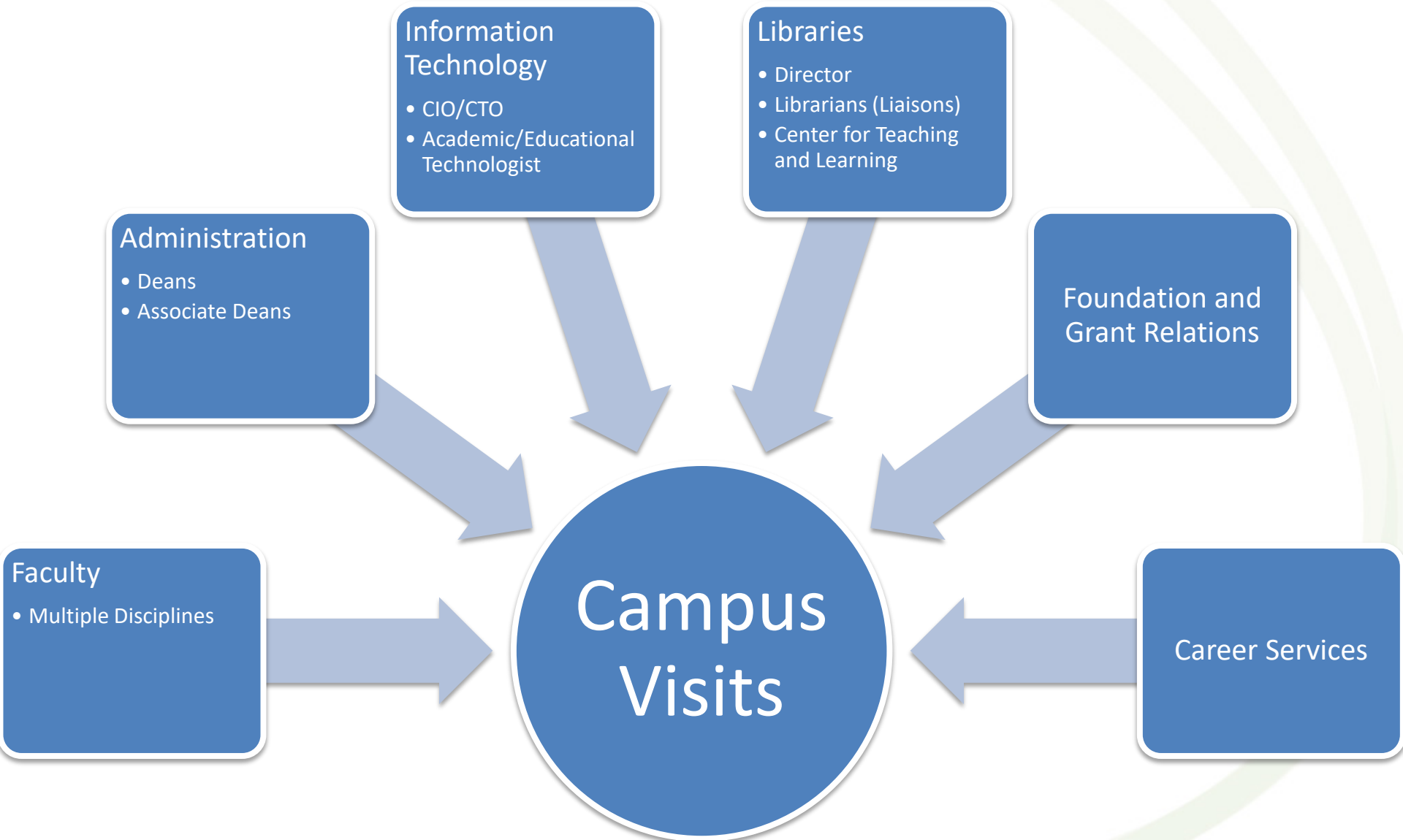
Grant Funding
