COMPASS ROSE FACT SHEET

Joszi Meskan, Designer. In the years Joszi Meskan owned Barbara Dorn Associates she has, with strength of purpose, continued to build a practice which stressed individuality of projects, with sensitivity towards history and local character. Her creations demonstrate appropriateness to context with attention to detail and exhibit a unique blend of drama and humor.

Blackamoors. Late 18th Century. Carved and Decorated. In the image of servants in stately Venetian House. Used to hold candelabra, flowers, cards, etc.

Bible Screen. Burmese—U-Thong Period, 16th Century. Gold Leaf, Leaves of Buddhist Prayers.

Bamboo Screen. Early 18th Century China. Handwoven Bamboo and Raffia. Used as backdrop for Chinese Minstrel Show. The writing is an invocation to the Muses of Dance and Song.

Cloisonné Vase. (2) 19th Century Korean. Enamel on Copper, color separation by fine Brass threads soldered to the Copper Base. Dragon Motif is shared by many countries. Japanese Dragons have 5 claws, Chinese have 4 and Koreans have 3 claws.

Reclining Goddess. 200 years old. Goddess is of Bronze and Semi-Precious Stones, made for use in a Temple in Thailand.

Settee (2). 18th Century English. Used in Music Room of Brighton Pavilion.

Cobra Lamps, Pair. 1920, Art Deco Period. Bronze, Original.

Accessory Tables. Moroccan, Turkish, Persian. Inlaid Mother of Pearl, Ivory and Tortoise Shell, mid to late 19th Century.

Mirrors. Middle Eastern, Lebanon. Lavishly Carved and Inlaid with Mother of Pearl. Used in Social Function Rooms of Grand Palaces. Very Rare.

Portrait. Early 18th Century. English—School of Hogarth.

Pewter Sconces. Circa 1860, English, Down Spout.

Aluminum/Glass Torchiers. Circa 1920, Art Deco, English Bowls.

Robe. Female Wedding Robe, early 1920. Phoenix Bird Design. Symbol of Empress. Hand Painted on Silk.

Table-Mosaic Marble. Victorian 1860, English with Italian Marbles.

Coromandel Cabinet. Radio Cabinet from 1920. There is a Poem on side doors which has not been translated.

Robe Stand. Early 19th Century Japanese. "Mon"—Family Crest decoration on Gold/Black Lacquer.

Buddha. Burmese Antique. Carved Wood. Polychrome.

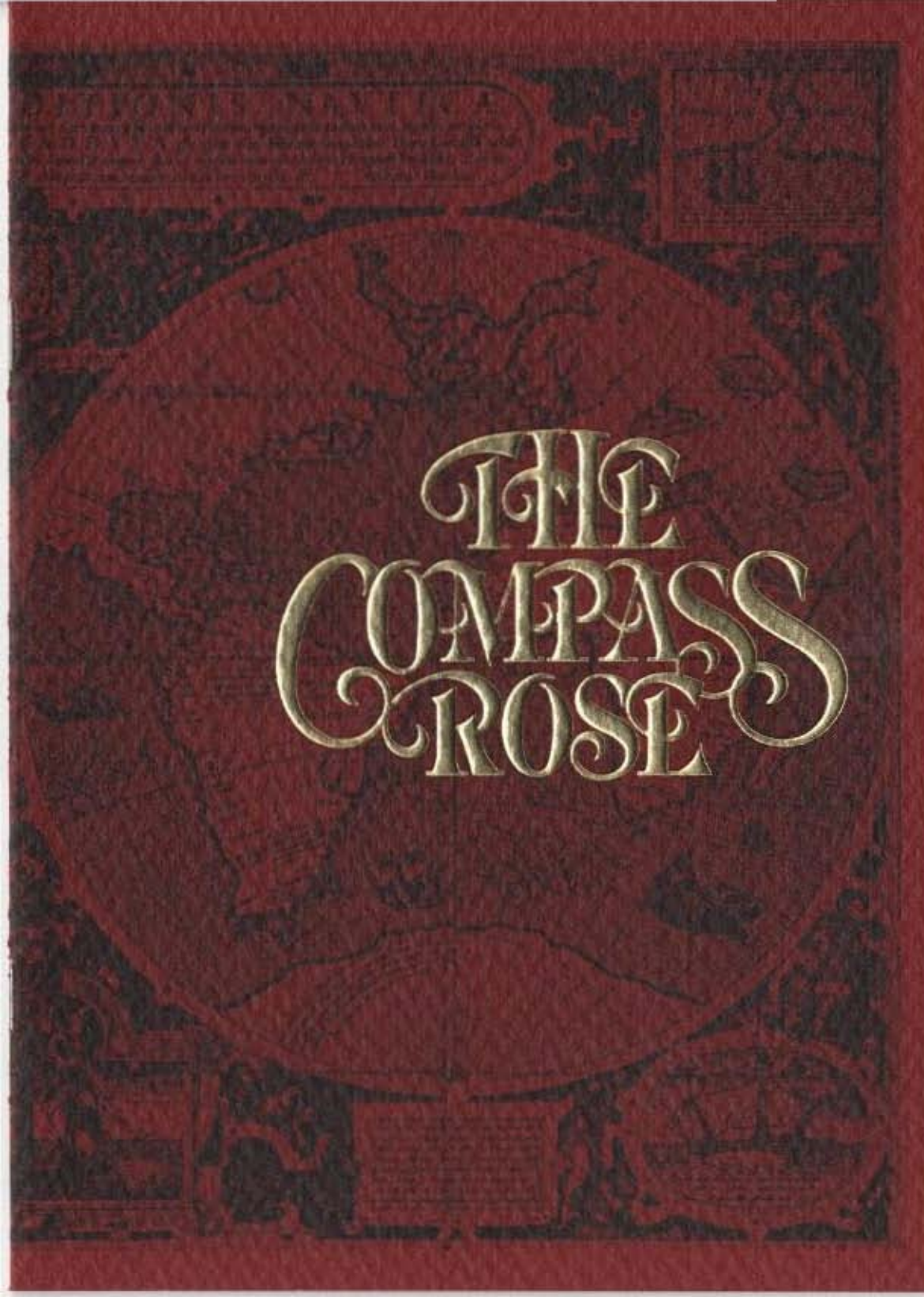
