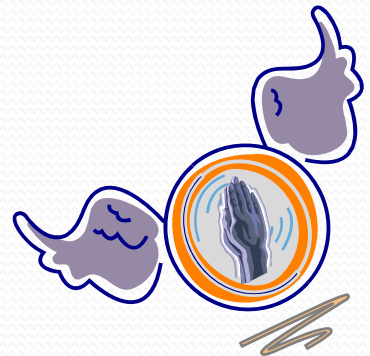

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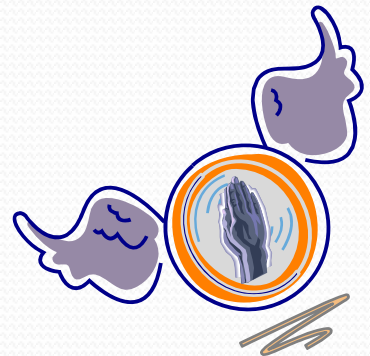
Butler Prof Development

- Butler Community College PD Program offers:
 - Full time instructors a salary advancement for every 120 hours of training (or 8 college credit hours)
 - Adjunct instructors a \$200 stipend to for every 10 hours of training (plus 1 meeting per year)
- Butler employs online faculty in France, South Africa and several states so we needed to provide training options to meet the various needs



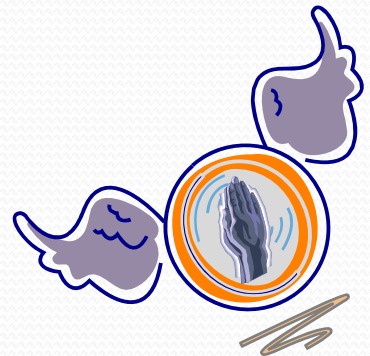
PD Opportunities

 - Summer EDventures



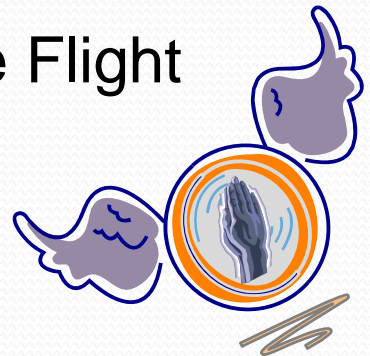
Face to Face Workshops

- Standard F2F workshop format
- Hands on training
- Usually 1 – 3 hours in length
- Offered on multiple campuses
- Mostly show and tell rather than results or project driven



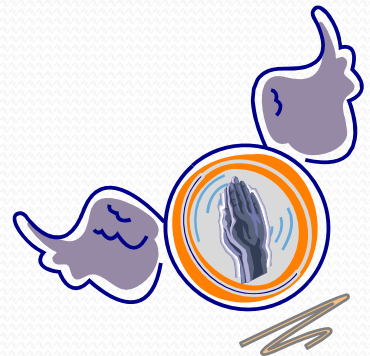
Face to Face Workshops

- Examples include:

 - Beyond Basic Podcasting
 - Harnessing the Power of ANGEL
 - What's New in ANGEL?
 - Secret Agents Man
 - Soaring in ANGEL: Tips and Tricks for the Flight



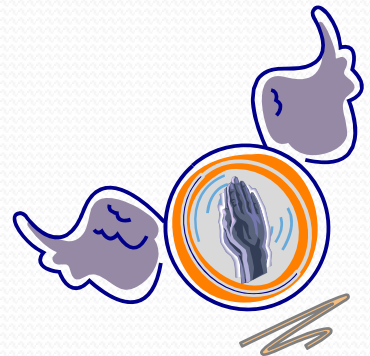
Blended Workshops

- Starts with standard F2F workshop format
- Hands on training
- Usually 2 – 5 hours in length
- Offered on multiple campuses
- Participants then must complete an agreed upon project after the hands on training to earn the additional points.



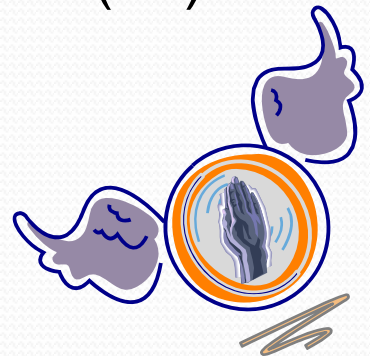
Blended Workshops

- Examples include:
 - Assessments in ANGEL
 - Best Practices in Blended Learning
 - Blogs & Wikis in ANGEL
 - Butler's Preferred Course Shell
 - Linking to Site Licensed Media



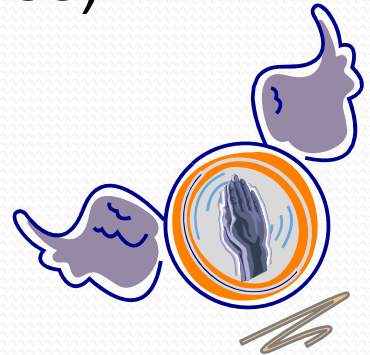
Online Workshops

- Some of our biggest workshops are offered using the online format only
- Usually 10 -30 hours in length
- Examples include:
 - ANGEL Basics (3 hours)
 - Introduction to Teaching Online (30)
 - Designing and Developing an Online Course (30)
 - Seven Principles of Good Practice in Undergraduate Education (25)



OnDemand Workshops

- Other workshop times not convenient
- Open for 12 weeks during the semester
- Faculty request to be enrolled and complete the work when it is convenient
- Little interaction between participants or between participants and instructor
- Project driven (changes to be made in class)
- Participant reports when workshop is completed and finished project is verified



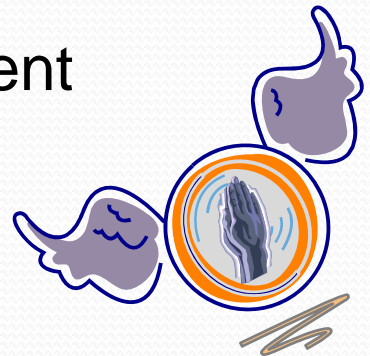
OnDemand Workshops

 - Wikis & Blogs



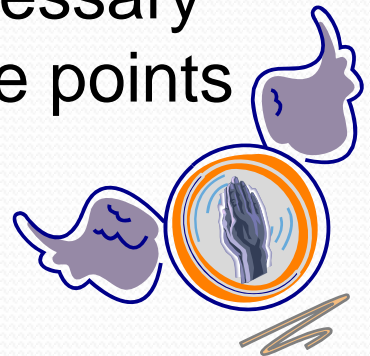
Special Projects

- Spring 2008
 - Podcasting project
 - 8 instructors
 - Each participant received \$400 in equipment
- Spring 2009
 - Vodcasting project
 - 12 instructors
 - Each participant received \$300 in equipment
- Project driven – blended format



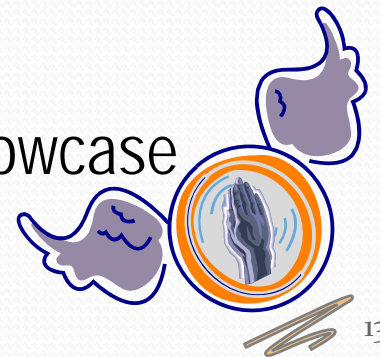
Summer EDventure

- Two day training opportunity (August 4 & 5)
- Five hours of training each night
- Late afternoons and evening sessions
(to improve connections with adjunct instructors)
- Four options in each time slot
- One to one consultation with IT specialist available
- This 10 hours of training will fulfill the necessary requirement for adjunct faculty earn all the points necessary for the \$200 stipend



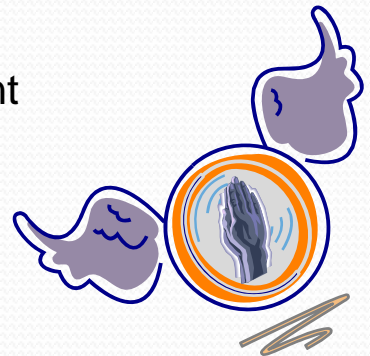
