Should I use Jing?

Pros

- Engaging
- Learners feel connected
- Distinguishes your class from another
- One-click access
- Videos must be less than 5 minutes in length

Cons

- Videos must be less than 5 minutes in length
- Technology learning curve
- No editing capabilities
- Cannot re-size a video once you have started the recording
