October 13, 1999

The LCBAS Curriculum Committee met on October 13, 1999, 11:00 a.m. in the Dean's Conference Room.

Members Present: T. Boldrey, M. Brown, K. Ketler, and R. Kopel

The meeting was called to order by Chair Brown.

MINUTES

R. Kopel (Boldrey) moved to approve the minutes of September 8, 1999, as published. Motion carried unanimously.

BUS MINOR PROPOSAL

R. Kopel (Boldrey) moved to approve the Business Minor including a new course, FIN 2710, as corrected. Motion was approved unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

The Accounting faculty have revised the prerequisites for ACC 3100, 3200, 3300, 4300, 4400, 4500, 4600, 4750, and 4800 and to add the new accounting standard for AACSB: "Of the total hours required for the degree, accounting majors should take at least 90 semester hours of courses outside the accounting discipline." This statement will be placed in the undergraduate catalog under Important Notice and has to do with the accounting change effective in the year 2001. Prerequisite changes would be effective Spring 2000. R. Kopel (Boldrey) moved to set aside the bylaws in order to take action on the Accounting proposal immediately so that changes can get in the undergraduate catalog. Motion carried unanimously. R. Kopel (Boldrey) moved to approve the change in Accounting prerequisites and the addition of the AACSB standard. Motion carried unanimously.
