***Stachytarpheta jamaicensis* (L.) Vahl**

ST. LUCIE COUNTY: Fort Pierce, 2199 South Rock Road, University of Florida, IFAS Indian River Research & Education Center, accessed N off W end of Pruitt Research Center Road (ca 3/4 mile W of C.R. 713, W of Rock Road, W of all the buildings), S of Picos Road, just E of the FL Turnpike; to N & W of coordinates. Canalized research fields with scattered remnants of native vegetation (especially to the W), i.e., weedy canal banks and edges of mowed fields, with *Cyanthillium cinereum*, *Urochloa mutica*, *Zornia bracteata*, *Chromolaena odorata*, *Cyperus surinamensis*, *C. iria*, *C. polystachyos*, *C. compressus*, *Aeschynomene indica*, *Ludwigia peruviana*, *Bidens alba*, *Arachis prostrata*, *Gomphrena serrata*, *Panicum repens*, *P. maximum*, *Macroptilium atropurpureus*, *Conyza canadensis*, *Richardia grandiflora*, *Indigofera hirsuta*, *Urena lobata*, *Chenopodium ambrosioides*, *Cenchrus echinatus*, *Desmodium triflorum*, *D. tortuosum*, *Paspalum notatum*, *Rhynchelytrum repens*, *Crotalaria lanceolata*, *C. pallida*, *Sporobolus indicus*, *Digitaria ciliaris*, *Schinus terebinthifolius*, *Vitis rotundifolia*, *Lygodium microphyllum*. Erect herb, flowers purple with white; infrequent.
