Associated species include: *Carya ovata*, *Quercus imbricaria*, *Juglans nigra*, *Prunus serotina*, *Cornus drummondii*, *Rosa multiflora*, *Toxicodendron radicans*, *Fallopia scandens*, *Scrophularia marilandica*, *Bromus inermis*, and *Aster shortii*.
