Hooper Branch Savanna Nature Preserve. UTM 16, 453277mE, 4539163mN.
Leesville 7.5 minute quadrangle. 2 mile south and 9 mile east of St. Anne.
Growing in open dry sand prairie surrounded by fields of *Populus tremuloides*, cultural community. Kankakee Sand Area of the Grand Prairie Natural Division, Elevation about 670 feet. Growing with *Populus tremuloides*, *Bromus tectorum*, *Fragaria*, *Krigia*, *Vulpia*, *Achillea millefolium*, *Linaria canadensis*, etc.
