Bentley/Crawford-Jordan Site. About 3.75 mile north (6 kilometer) and 9.4 mile east
(13.55 kilometer) of town of St. Anne. Leesville 7.5 minute quadrangle. Elevation
about 675 feet.
Growing in dry-mesic sand savanna. Growing with *Quercus alba* (dominant), *Rhus*
glabra, *Prunus serotina*, *Vaccinium angustifolium*, etc. Perennial herb, flowers blue.
