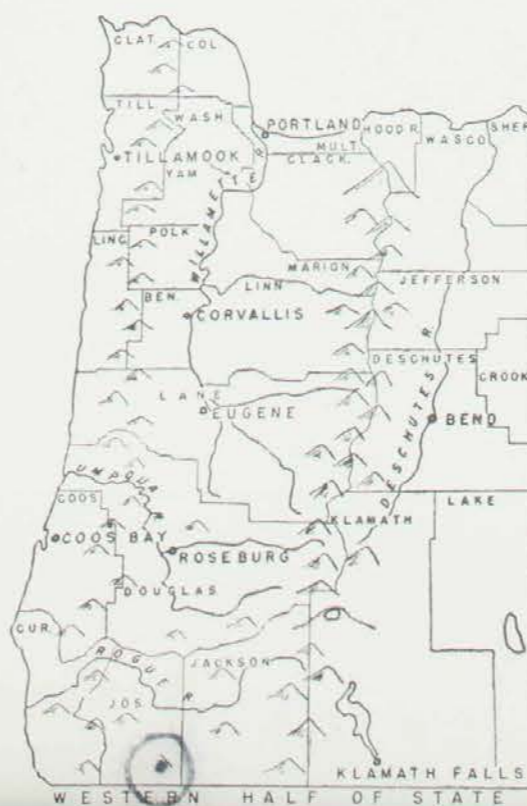
LEWISIA LEANA (Porter) Robinson

Succulent rosette from tuberous root; flowers pink.

Common locally in rock cleft in coniferous forest zone; with Sedum, Montia, Calochortus & Penstemon; dry loam soil; elev. 5,500 feet.

JOSEPHINE COUNTY: North slope of Miller's Peak, about 6 miles (air-line) southeast of Oregon Caves; near Cupressus Bakeri grove.
